

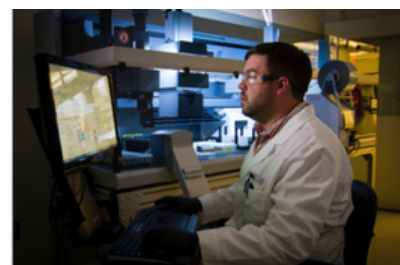
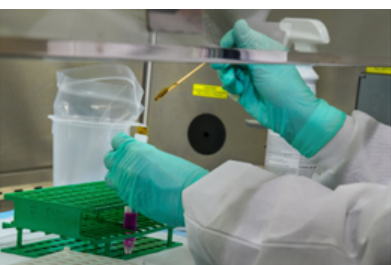

UPDATED TEMPLATES

Please note that the consent form templates, accessible in Nagano, have been updated. A new clause regarding the use of third-party software (Zoom, Teams, Fitness or tracking application, etc.) has been added. The instructions in the form of comments have been improved to help research teams prepare their consent forms.

PROJECT EXAMINATION



As of January 2024, all research projects submitted as part of an institutional suitability assessment (convenience) are examined by the DAUER knowledge translation and innovation unit in order to identify potential for mobilizing research output beyond what is planned by the research team. Researchers will be contacted for this purpose only if necessary. This review is independent of the process leading to project authorization and will not result in any additional delays.

ABOUT NAGANO

»»» TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION SYSTEM

As many of you will have noticed, you now have to enter a code sent to your e-mail address every time you log on to Nagano. The introduction of this two-factor authentication system is the result of an obligation imposed by the Ministry for Cyber Security and Digital Technology. To date, no problems have been reported. RECEIVING NOTIFICATIONS

Did you know that to receive notifications from Nagano, you need to configure your account? In your Nagano profile, click the blue “Edit” button on the right and make sure “no emailing” is unchecked. Also, for each project on which you are a user, make sure that the “email” button is checked next to your name in “Research Team”. For more details, see “Memo regarding e-mails” in the Nagano documentation section.

NOTIFICATION ISSUES

Each time an operation is performed in Nagano, a notification is sent to project users. These notifications were classified as spam by the institution's cybersecurity systems. This issue is now resolved but we cannot predict if and when these issues may reoccur. Therefore, Nagano users are strongly advised to regularly consult the platform to see the latest activities and to write to recherche.comtl@ssss.gouv.qc.ca to report any problems.
