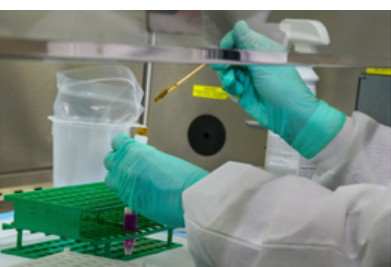

>>> SUMMARY SHEETS

Over the course of 2026, research teams will be contacted to complete a brief summary sheet outlining the results of their research projects — once those projects are completed or when their data-analysis phase enters its second year. These sheets will be written in lay language, revised by the TC-Inno service, and then shared with the staff of the directorates that authorized the project.

This initiative will help increase the visibility of your research, strengthen understanding of its clinical impacts, and support its integration into practice—thereby contributing to the advancement of leading-edge practices within our organization. For more information, please visit our website.

RESEARCHERS CONSULTATION GROUP

The RRASU is launching a new version of its consultation group (see the [February 2024 newsletter](#)). This advisory group will allow the Academic Affairs and Innovation Directorate (DAAI) to better understand research needs. As the DAAI is responsible for the academic mission and the oversight of research and innovation at the CIUSSS, it is responsible for implementing a multitude of initiatives, activities, and services in support of this mission and for ensuring all related operations.

The objective of the advisory group will be to review and comment on proposals about the development, implementation, modification, and smooth operation of services and activities developed by the DAAI in connection with the academic mission, research, and innovation.

LIST OF DEPARTMENTS AND THEIR FEASIBILITY EVALUATORS

Each directorate appoints a manager responsible for evaluating the research projects submitted to them. These individuals act as feasibility (convenience) reviewers and serve as points of contact between research teams and clinical teams, particularly during the implementation of the project.
